

- 278 Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies









FAQ'S FROM PARTNERS



Who can provide verification that an applicant is at your school and has access to at least 15 hours a week in a classroom?

A: Principal or other school leader from your campus/district, as this is not a formal employment verification.



Can an employee apply to Reach if they have already earned a bachelor's degree?

A: Our program is designed for applicants who have earned no more than 60 credits, an associate's degree or less.



If a candidate is no longer employed at your school/district, who should be notified?

A: The candidate should notify their Candidate Services Advisor immediately of the change. Partners can also notify a member of the Partnerships Team.



Can Reach share a candidate's academic progress with a partner or employer?

A: No, FERPA laws do not allow us to release academic information. We recommend employers have a signed agreement with their employees stating expectations in advance.




What level is Reach authorized for certification in Louisiana?

A: The candidate will be certified for grades 1-5 and mild to mod Special Education.

cost, each candidate is offered the \$900 a year cost.

What is the actual cost of the bachelor's degree program?

A: The full program cost is approximately \$14,000 per academic year.

Who should the district contact if planning to pay towards a candidate's cost of attendance?

A: Fill out the <u>intake form</u> or communicate plans directly by emailing Bursar@reach.edu.

When will partners be invoiced for candidate bills?

A: Beginning next year January 15/August 15 of each year, however partners must provide the candidate(s) info before the deadline to ensure candidate is not billed.






21 STATES WITH K-12 TEACHER RAP'S. (REACH IS IN FIVE OF THOSE STATES)

Craft Tracker: Streamlined Process

- Weekly Hours Now Verified ONCE at the beginning and ONCE at the end of the Semester by HR
- Competencies and Capstones tracked/verified at the end of the semester



Clinical Residency: Here we go!

- Year long (with gradual release leading up to semester of teaching)
- If teaching status of candidates changes, make sure they are in compliance with ADE requirements (i.e. passed licensure)
