

Reach University is an accredited, non-profit university offering a job-embedded Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies for adults working in schools.

Our full-time, online program is built for working adults. Candidates earn college credit while working with one of our partner school districts. Classes are scheduled in the evenings to accommodate work schedules. With grants, sponsorships, and scholarships, **Reach candidates will pay no more than \$79/month**.

Who can apply?

To be eligible, you must meet all of the following conditions:



Be employed in Colorado.



Work for one of our partner school systems in Colorado.



Work with children in an academic setting at least 15 hrs/week.



Be at least 18 years old.



Have a high school diploma or GED.



Do not already have a bachelor's degree.

Program Duration & Transfer Credit Policy

The length of time to complete the degree depends on the number of transfer-level college credits earned by the candidate prior to enrollment.



Candidates entering with zero college credits will complete the degree in

4 YEARS



Candidates transferring 30 college credits will complete the degree in

3 YEARS



Candidates entering with a conferred associate's degree will complete the degree in

2 YEARS

Upon completion of the BA in Liberal Studies degree, candidates interested in becoming a teacher will need to enroll in a state-approved alternative certification program.

Affordable Tuition

Through a mix of grants, sponsorships, and scholarships, candidates pay \$79/month (\$900/year) for attendance, including books & materials.

Job-Embedded Learning

Our job-embedded model means that half the learning comes from work with students and you earn college credit while doing your job.

Full-Time Program

Candidates enroll in 12-15 units per term and are expected to dedicate 20-25 hours per week for learning in and out of the classroom.
